


CHILDCARE RULES AND REGULATIONS

Catholics United for the Faith 40th Anniversary Conference

October 10–12, 2008

- All children using the childcare area must be pre-registered.
- All parents using the childcare for their children must volunteer sometime during the conference. Volunteer times are listed on the registration form. We will try to accommodate the times that are requested but cannot guarantee you will get that exact time. Times will be assigned on a first come first serve basis. Your exact time will be verified 1–2 weeks prior to the conference.
- Volunteers can consist of parents, guardians, grandparents, and teenage girls ages 14 and older.
- A release form must be signed per family prior to children being admitted into childcare.
- Childcare is for children ages 2-12 years of age only. Parents are asked to make other accommodations for smaller children. Infants may accompany parents into the main conference area. Please remember that a crying infant is a disruption to those around you.
- Each parent and child will be given a coordinating wristband that must be worn at all times. Children will only be released from their age group room to a parent or guardian with a matching wristband.
- Parents are responsible for feeding their children. Absolutely no food or drink is permitted in the childcare rooms and no exceptions will be made. **(Please note that the food provided at the conference is for paid participants only.)**
- Parents are responsible for all diaper changes.
- If your child cries for more than 10 minutes or becomes unruly, their first name and ID# will be placed on the childcare message board located in the main conference area. Parents are expected to check the board regularly and if their child's name appears to pick them up immediately.
- Childcare opens a half an hour prior to the start of the conference and will close during meal times.
- Some games and activities will be provided. Children are encouraged to bring books and other quiet games and activities from home.
